First Aid at Work (FAW)

Three-day course. Valid for three years, with the recommendation of a half day refresher each year. Accredited and certificated, according to the FAW syllabus. This course will give you the knowledge and confidence to deal with a first aid emergency in the workplace. You will be eligible to be a nominated First Aider at your workplace

First Aid at Work (Requalification)

Two-day course to re-qualify existing first aiders. Accredited and certificated. The course aims to update and refresh your knowledge of the First aid at work syllabus while allowing time for revision and practice sessions in preparation for a final assessment

Emergency First Aid at Work Course (EFAW)

One-day course low-risk workplaces. Accredited and certificated. Basic lifesaving, first aid and workplace health and safety regulations, according to the EFAW syllabus.

We adapt each course to the work that you do and ensure that we cover the types of injuries that you may face. We consider how your first aiders can get the emergency services to the casualty, especially if you work in remote locations such as a farm or industrial site. We offer remote medical training for the jungle, arctic and desert environments
